Morgan Partners in 1990, Mr. Chavkin was one of the first members of Chemical Bank's Merchant Banking Group and its Corporate Finance Group, specializing in mergers and acquisitions and private placements for the energy industry. Earlier in his career, he held positions at Freeport McMoRan, Gulf and Western Industries and Arthur Young & Company. Mr. Chavkin is a member of the Columbia Business School Board of Overseers.
